As a consequence of Eltronic is expanding its global activities a new development and test center has been build. The building contains project offices and welfare facilities in the main building's three floors, project office and workshop in the center building and assembly and test facilities in the buildings to the north. A Total of 4500 m², with room for 150 engineers and technicians.

The building is constructed in a modern timeless architecture with bright, natural surfaces build in simple and tight lines, where the architecture reflects the building's use and accessibility. Office areas are located with a focus on minimal distance to all areas as well as flexibility and openness for interaction among employees.

From all the main building's three floors there is a clear view of the countryside, forest and lake to the south. From the ground floor canteen there is access to recreational areas outside the building. The building's form and location ensures noise-related and visual shielding against Kilde Allé.

The building is constructed with emphasis on energy efficient solutions both in the physical design and the technical installations. For example, there is, incorporated automatic control of lighting and heat so that energy consumption and indoor environment is optimized continuously. Also, all use of water for welfare facilities, is supplemented with heat from solar cells.
